Well here we are again and Spring is Springing. It always seems like Winter will never end. Driving around the campground and seeing the shades of green as different trees and plants fill out is so relaxing. I hope you can come up and enjoy the camp this time of year.

Now to inform you of old things, new things and to emphasize the rules as we start a new camping season.

We have a Club Meeting the first Sunday of the month at 10:00 a.m. starting in March and ending in November here at the Clubhouse. The following information has been discussed at these meetings. For those of you who cannot attend this is information that you need to know.

Let's start at the new gate. The old gate needed repair and the cost of repair was almost as much as buying a whole new system. We did that and it has been installed. What you need to know. This gate is not just a board that can be replaced by going down to the lumber yard. It is a special composite material that will have to be ordered for replacement. The cost of replacement has not been determined but it would be considerably more than before. Fair warning that you do not want to break this gate. The gate is set to let one vehicle through at a time, **do not** tailgate through. A nice feature is that it will bounce back up if it comes down on anything in its path. This could result in breaking the gate and/or a dent in your vehicle.

Now that you are on the Campground, remember to obey the road rules. Ten miles per hour or less. Rules of the road apply in the Campground the same as on the public highway. A driver with a driver permit must have a licensed driver ride along and a license needs to be in possession to drive any moving vehicle. No exceptions.

The roads have been a problem the last few weeks. The road going to the 700 level is down to one lane in a section that washed out and had to be rebuilt. A section of the road on the 500 level has been repaired.

We have an ongoing problem with the disposal of dog waste. Dog stations have been set up throughout the campground. It seems that the bags are being used but then it seems the disposal of bags filled with dog waste is becoming the next problem. The plan is to have containers to put those bags into and they may be installed by the Memorial Day weekend. In the meantime please do not flush them down the toilets or throw them into the bushes along side of the road. This is your home away from home, please be courteous and thoughtful of the care of your home. We all live here.

Logging has been done along the road of the 400 level. The owner of the property has given permission to take down any trees on his property along the road that could be considered dangerous. This has been done. He also gave permission to take any wood from the logged off area for personal use. As a result of the logging we did a survey of the property and we are on the adjoining property on some lots by a very small portion. The owner is not concerned about this.

The Ray Bovee Library has been completed. Thanks to Sid Sack and his wife for painting the interior and putting the books back on the shelves. Sid has been keeping it neat and orderly. You are welcome to any items in the library and we welcome any books, VCR tapes, DVD's and items for children. Bring your donated items and put them in the bins provided and they will be put on the shelves.

Steve Johnson is in the process of redoing the small playground on the 100 level. The swing set is being replaced as the beam on the old one is rotten. He has also been doing the doggie stations and working on keeping the flower beds cleaned up. Thank you to Steve and his helpers.

After much discussion it was determined that the Nature Trail will be closed permanently. It is too dangerous for use and too costly to make it useable.

Just a reminder that a \$75. deposit is required when the Clubhouse is reserved for use. The deposit is refundable when the area is left clean. Cleaning supplies will be provided.

We have had some reports of damage being done on membership lots by unknown persons. Along the same line there has been some security problems reported. Please be aware and report any problem to the Ranger or any Board Member.

There have been some misunderstandings about tree and vegetation cutting. Trees over 4" in diameter should not be cut without permission. Each request is treated individually. Vegetation growing in greenbelts and along roads should not be cut without permission also. The wetlands are completely off limits for any cutting. If there is any question about what is allowed, please ask before proceeding.

Many general repairs and upkeep have been done these past few months. The backhoe and boom truck have had repairs and still have some to go. New doors have been purchased for the new library and laundry. Fireplace insert has been installed but not operational until the chimney is finished. Work has been done on the wells. A new freezer and a used freezer have been purchased.

A new power push mower has been purchased. A defibulator was purchased from Costco. It is available through the Ranger and when he is not on the grounds it will be at the gate trailer. The men's bathroom at the Clubhouse is in the process of repairs. The floor repair needs warmer weather in order to finish. The stumps around the propane tank at the Clubhouse have been removed and the area leveled. The old woodshed at the Clubhouse will be torn down and a new one built over in the area where the fire pit is located.

Unfortunately the kitchen area of the addition is still ongoing. Permitting for electrical, plumbing and gas hook-ups are in progress and until these areas are approved the kitchen cannot be completed. Two new stainless steel tables and new picnic tables have been purchased from Costco.

The two main holiday weekends we have are Memorial Day and Labor Day. Fourth of July is hit or miss because it often falls on weekdays. If some of you could see fit to volunteer in the kitchen for cooking, serving or cleaning it would be a great help. All the work is done on a volunteer basis and the more help we have the less each has to work. Volunteers are entered automatically in a drawing for prizes that are only available to volunteers.

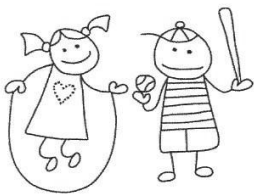
We also could use prizes and volunteers for the Children and Adult raffles and the Kids games.

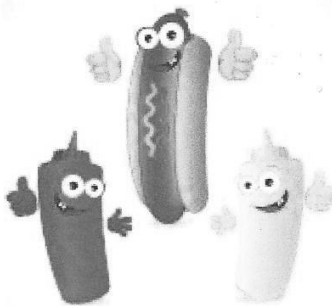

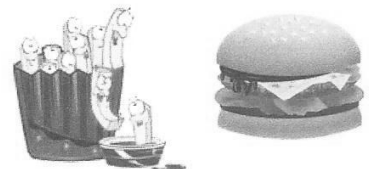
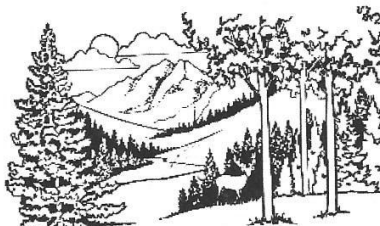
